

The Whirlwind of Yahweh

1. Risk management
2. The observed and projected changes in extreme weather
3. The vulnerability and losses resulting from climate and weather events.
4. Adaptation options on a local and international scale.
5. Disaster recovery and disaster risk management.

This report was structured for the policymakers of all nations (SPM) to begin to prepare for major economic and catastrophic damages. The report describes for the policymaker a universal understanding of the challenges we face. Here is how the nations define the core concepts regarding our current climate disturbances:

“Climate Change: A change in the state of the climate that can be identified (e.g., by using statistical tests) by changes in the mean And/or the variability of its properties and that persists for an extended period, typically decades or longer. Climate change may be due to natural internal processes or external forcing, or to persistent anthropogenic changes in the composition of the atmosphere or in Land use.²

Climate Extreme (extreme weather or climate event): The occurrence of a value of a weather or climate variable above (or below) a threshold value near the upper (or lower) ends of the range of observed values of the variable. For simplicity, both extreme weather events and extreme climate events are referred to collectively as ‘climate extremes.’ The full definition is provided in Section 3.1.2.

Exposure: The presence of people; livelihoods; environmental services and resources; infrastructure; or economic, social, or cultural assets in places that could be adversely affected.

Vulnerability: The propensity or predisposition to be adversely affected.

Disaster: Severe alterations in the normal functioning of a community or a society due to hazardous physical events interacting with vulnerable social conditions, leading to widespread adverse human, material, economic, or environmental effects that require immediate emergency response to satisfy critical human needs and that may require external support for recovery.

Disaster Risk: The likelihood over a specified time period of severe alterations in the normal functioning of a community or a society due to hazardous physical events interacting with vulnerable social conditions, leading to widespread adverse human, material, economic, or environmental effects that require immediate emergency response to satisfy critical human needs and that may require external support for recovery.

Disaster Risk Management: Processes for designing, implementing, and evaluating strategies, policies, and measures to improve the understanding of disaster risk, fosters disaster risk reduction and transfer, and promote continuous improvement in disaster preparedness, response, and recovery practices, with the explicit purpose of increasing human security, well-being, quality of life, resilience, and sustainable development.

Adaptation: In human systems, the process of adjustment to actual or expected climate and its effects, in order to moderate harm or exploit beneficial opportunities. In natural systems, the process of adjustment to actual climate and its effects; human intervention may facilitate adjustment to expected climate.

Resilience: The ability of a system and its component parts to anticipate, absorb, accommodate, or recover from the effects of a hazardous event in a timely and efficient manner, including through ensuring the preservation, restoration, or improvement of its essential basic structures and functions.

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Transformation: The altering of fundamental attributes of a system (including value systems; regulatory, legislative, or bureaucratic regimes; financial institutions; and technological or biological systems).

This report continue to explain and places important emphases on preparing for both economic and structural damage that will cause discomfort in every region the extreme weather conditions exist. The IPCC discloses the alteration they have observed since the 1950's of changes attributed to human activities that have altered the atmospheric composition. The alterations are the result of secret governmental programs carried out by the governments of the earth. The human activities they attribute to these disturbances are the result of their military pursuits. 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governments would change the ordinances of both heaven and earth resulting in natural disasters in the form of earthquakes, droughts, and hurricanes.

In the Last Days You will understand it perfectly

The prophet Yereyah is given the prophecy concerning a whirlwind of Yahweh that will be raised up along a coast of earth. We will examine this prophecy in detail to disclose to the world the power Yahweh has to predict future events. The events he inspires to be written are major events that will always occupy the attention of man, causing them to search for the cause and reason for their calamity. The prophet Yereyah was inspired to reiterate this prophecy in his work three times to validate the fulfillment of his prediction. Let's begin this work in the following scripture:

For who has stood in the counsel of Yahweh, and has perceived and heard his word? Who has marked his word, and heard *it*? Behold, a whirlwind of Yahweh is gone forth in fury, even a grievous whirlwind: it shall fall grievously upon the head of the wicked. The anger (*judgment*) of Yahweh shall not return, until he has executed, and till he has performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days you shall consider it perfectly.

Jeremiah 23:18-20 (PNV-KJV)

The word **whirlwind** is from the Hebrew word: **סַעֲרָה** se'ārâ [<H5591>](#)— (feminine) *ce`arah*, seh-aw-raw'; from [<H5590>](#) (ca`ar); **a hurricane: - storm** (-y), tempest, whirlwind.—Strong's Concordance.

סַעַר sā'ar [<H5590>](#)— a primitive root; to *rush* upon; by implication to *toss* (transitive or intransitive, literal or figurative):- be (toss with) tempest — Strong's Concordance.

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The word **whirlwind** is revealing a hurricane that is predicted to be stirred up in the last days. The destructive nature of this hurricane is described in the meaning of the Hebrew word “se’ārâ” as a destructive hurricane whirling and sweeping away everything in its path. The prophet as we will see speaks of two distinct hurricanes the he saw devastating the coastal cities of a particular nation fulfilling the prediction of this prophecy. Let’s return to the prophecy given by Yeremyah the prophet:

For who has stood in the counsel of Yahweh, and has perceived and heard his word? Who has marked his word, and heard *it*? Behold, a whirlwind of Yahweh is gone forth in fury, even a grievous whirlwind: it shall fall grievously upon the head of the wicked. The anger (*judgment*) of Yahweh shall not return, until he has executed, and till he has performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly.

Jeremiah 23:18-20 (PNV-KJV)

Notice the word **fury** written in Jeremiah 23:19 is from the Hebrew word: חֶמָה ḥēmâ <H2534>— *chema'*, khay-maw'; from <H3179> (yacham); **heat**; figurative furious, **heat, indignation, poison, rage, wrath**. Strong’s Concordance

חָמַם— y am < 3179>: a primitive root; probably **to be hot; figurative to conceive**: - **get heat**, be hot, conceive, be warm. Chema: Heat from the sun; making warm the waters; causing the water become hot, to kindle a fire in from natural heat. Strong’s Concordance.

The word fury is describing the cause of the raging of the sea which ultimately leads to a destructive hurricane because of the heating up of the ocean waters. The Hebrew word chema’ is describing also an external influence of a compressive force which causes the natural heating of the surface being compressed.

The word **grievous** written in Jeremiah 23:19 from the Hebrew word: חִיל ḥîl <H2342>— or *chiyl*, kheel; a primitive root; **properly to twist or whirl (in a circular or spiral manner), i.e. specific to pervert :- (make to) bring forth, (make to) fall grievously with pain**—Strong’s Concordance

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חַיִל *îl*: The Hebrew and Chaldee Lexicon to Old Testament by Julius Fuerst page 426 means: **The weather as a precursor of the divine wrath.**

The word *grievous* is describing the enormous power and strength of this hurricane, that will cause massive destruction and grievous pain upon the head of the wicked. The word *wicked* is revealing the moral iniquity associated with a category of people who have done wrong and or still bent on living in sin. They challenge Yahweh with their evil devices (inventions) which alter his creation for greed and power. They are responsible for shedding blood and as a result they have broken the everlasting covenant binding upon all nations.

And surely lifeblood of your lives will I require (*an accounting*); at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man. Whoso sheds man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of Yahweh made he man.

Genesis 9:5-6 (KJV)

The wicked here are described by the prophet as those who by their evil actions cause devastating consequences to fall upon themselves and everyone around them. Notice with me the prophet Yereyah description of another destructive hurricane he predicted will arise in the last days.

A *noise* shall come *even* to the **ends of the earth**; for Yahweh has **a controversy** with the nations, he will **plead** with all flesh; he will give them *that are* wicked to the sword, says Yahweh. This what Yahweh of hosts says, Behold, **evil shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.** And the slain of Yahweh shall be at that day from *one end* of the earth even unto the *other end* of the earth: they shall not be lamented, neither gathered, nor buried; they shall be dung upon the ground.

Jeremiah 25:31-33 (KJV)

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The word **noise** written in Jeremiah 25: 31 is from the Hebrew word: שֹׁאֵן sh 'ôn <H7588— from <H7582> (sha'ah); *uproar* (as of *rushing*); by implication *destruction*: - horrible, noise, pomp, rushing, and a tumult. Strong's Concordance

שָׂאָה sh 'â <H7582>— a primitive root; to *rush*; by implication to *desolate*: - be desolate, (make a) rush (-ing), to lay waste. —Strong's Concordance

: שֹׁאֵן sh 'ôn: The Brown-Driver-Briggs Hebrew and English Lexicon by F.Brown,S.Driver, and C. Briggs page 981: show this word means: a roar of waters; the crashing and uproar of waves. A devastating storm; a wasting tempest used of waves laying waste something.

The word **noise** is describing the turbulent nature of this destructive storm resulting in the roaring and stirring of the sea that destroys everything in its path.

The word **controversy** written in Jeremiah 25:31 is from the Hebrew word: רִיב rîb <H7379—or *rib*, reeb; from <H7378> (riyb); a *contest* (personal or legal): a cause, a controversy, pleading, strive (-ing), a suit; Rib: also means to rebuke; to conduct a legal case; make a charge, to indict. —Strong's Concordance

The word **indict** is found in the Webster Dictionary page 972: ***To charge with an offense or crime; accuse of wrongdoing; initiating a criminal case.***

The word controversy is describing a legal case charging the nations with a crime declared to the nations from the Heavenly Court of Yahweh. The word plead written in Jeremiah 25:31 is revealing a process of litigation were the heavenly court gives the reason for its indictment and declares to the nations a warning admonishing them to reform their ways. The attempt of this pleading is to convince the nations of their wrongdoings and cause them to acknowledge that Yahweh is true.

Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and show us former things? Let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say (*acknowledge*), *It is truth.*

Isaiah 43:9 (KJV)

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This indictment will be expounded in the work entitled Earthquakes in Place after Place of the governmental involvement in the extreme weather patterns and alteration of the earth's atmosphere. Notice again the following scriptures:

A noise shall come *even* to the ends of the earth; for Yahweh has a controversy with the nations, he will plead with all flesh; he will give them *that are* wicked to the sword, says Yahweh. This what Yahweh of hosts says, Behold, evil shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth. And the slain of Yahweh shall be at that day from *one end* of the earth even unto the *other end* of the earth: they shall not be lamented, neither gathered, nor buried; they shall be dung upon the ground.

Jeremiah 25:31-33 (KJV)

The phrase evil shall go forth is from the Hebrew word: רָעַר ra' <H7451> from <H7489> (ra`a`); *bad* or (as noun) *evil* (natural or moral):- adversity, affliction, calamity, distress —Strong's Concordance

The word calamity is from the Webster Dictionary page 294 means: 1. a great misfortune or disaster, as a flood etc. syn. Catastrophe, cataclysm.

Disaster: Webster Dictionary page 561: 1. A calamitous event, especially one occurring suddenly and causing great loss of life, damage, or hardship. 2. A unfavorable aspect of a star or planet. The prefix Dis- is a Latin prefix which means having a privative, negative or reversing force and aster (astro) means a star. Please remember this because as we continue with this prophecy you will see this star associated with the word disaster is prophesied of in the Holy Scriptures.

The phrase evil shall go forth is describing the calamitous events describe here as disasters, that will cause great loss of life, and damage throughout the nations. The IPCC's report we spoke of earlier, describes the extreme weather and climate events as having the capability to cause catastrophic destruction. The IPCC report focuses on disaster risk management plan to deal with extreme climate events, they anticipate will impact all nations in the near future. The prophet Yeremyah prophesied of disaster and today we have the United Nations and IPCC warning all nations to prepare for climate and weather related disasters. Let's return again to the prophecy given to us by Yeremyah the prophet:

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A noise shall come *even* to the ends of the earth; for Yahweh has a controversy with the nations, he will plead with all flesh; he will give them *that are* wicked to the sword, says Yahweh. This what Yahweh of hosts says, Behold, evil shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind (hurricane) shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth. And the slain of Yahweh shall be at that day from *one end* of the earth even unto the *other end* of the earth: they shall not be lamented, neither gathered, nor buried; they shall be dung upon the ground.

Jeremiah 25:31-33 (KJV)

The word **raised up** written in the above scripture is from the Hebrew word: עִוַּר 'ûr <H5782— a primitive root [rather identical with <H5783> (‘uwr) through the idea of opening the eyes]; to *wake* (literal or figurative):- rise (up), *stir up*. Uwr: **describes a stirring up and inciting something to activity.** —Strong's Concordance

עִוַּר 'ûr: The Hebrew and Chaldee Lexicon to the Old Testament by Julius Fuerst page 1029 shows this word to mean: **A stirring up; the idea of something being excited or aroused; to rise of a storm; to be heated, to be hot, seething, boiling and bubbling up.** Notice this fact being reported about Hurricane Sandy in this news article:

“Global warming systemically caused the huge and ferocious Hurricane Sandy. And consequently, it systemically caused all the loss of life, material damage, and economic loss of Hurricane Sandy. Global warming heated the water of the Gulf and Mexico and the Atlantic Ocean, resulting in greatly increased energy and water vapor in the air above the water. When that happens, extremely energetic and wet storms occur more frequently and ferociously. These systemic effects of global warming came together to produce the ferocity and magnitude of Hurricane Sandy. This is no small matter because the fate of the earth is at stake. The science is excellent. The scientists' ability to communicate is lacking. Without the words, the idea cannot even be expressed. And without an understanding of systemic causation, we cannot understand what is hitting us.

Global warming is real, and it is here. It is causing -- yes, causing -- death, destruction, and vast economic loss. And the causal effects are getting greater with time. We cannot merely adapt to it. The costs are incalculable. What we are facing is huge. Each day, the amount of extra energy accumulating via the

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heating of the earth is the equivalent of 400,000 Hiroshima atomic bombs. Each day! (Global Warming Systematically Caused Hurricane Sandy By George Lakoff 11-4-2012).

The heating up of the earth is also shown by Yahweh to be extreme in this generation. We will discuss briefly this fact, but the details of what is causing this increasing threat will be expounding in a work that will precede this one entitled Earthquakes in Place after Place. The prophet of Yahweh describes in scripture the extreme heating shown by Mr. George Lakoff above. Notice this in the following scriptures:

And there shall be upon every high mountain and upon every high hill, rivers *and* streams of waters in the day of the great slaughter, when the towers fall. **Moreover the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day that Yahweh binds up the breach of his people, and heals the stroke of their wound.**

Isaiah 30:25-26 (KJV)

Therefore shall the strong people glorify thee, the city of the terrible nations shall fear thee. **For you have been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones is as a storm against the wall.**

Isaiah 25:3-4 (KJV)

They shall not hunger nor thirst; **neither shall the heat nor sun smite them**: for he that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide them.

Isaiah 49:10 (KJV)

And the fourth malak poured out his vial upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire. **And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of Yahweh, which has power over these plagues**: and they repented not to give him glory.

Revelation 16:8-9 (KJV)

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The scriptures prove Yahweh predicted the earth would experience a time when scorching heat would cause major disturbances in the earth. He shows that man will blame him for their plagues, but is a known fact that our own sins have reached into the heavens causing the earth to become sick, and the curses associated with sin to devour the earth. Let's return once more to the prophecy of Yeremyah concerning a great hurricane that will be stirred up.

A noise shall come *even* to the ends of the earth; for Yahweh has a controversy with the nations, he will plead with all flesh; he will give them *that are* wicked to the sword, says Yahweh. This what Yahweh of hosts says, Behold, evil shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind (hurricane) shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth. And the slain of Yahweh shall be at that day from *one end* of the earth even unto the *other end* of the earth: they shall not be lamented, neither gathered, nor buried; they shall be dung upon the ground.

Jeremiah 25:31-33 (KJV)

Notice this great hurricane will be raised up along the coast of the earth a coast is defined as a land next to the sea, or bordering large bodies of water. I want you to notice the phrase the slain of Yahweh will be from one end of the earth even to the other end of the earth.

The word end written in the above scripture is from the Hebrew word: קֶשֶׁה qēṣeh [<H7097>](#)— *qetseh*, kay'-tseh; from [<H7096>](#) (qatsah); an *extremity* (used in a great variety of applications and idioms; compare [<H7093>](#) (qets)):- border, a coast; a shore. — Strong's Concordance

The word earth written in the above scripture is from the Hebrew word: אֶרֶץ 'ereṣ [<H776>](#)— from an unused root probably meaning to *be firm*; the *earth* (at large, or partitively a land):- × a country, land, nations. **Erets: quite frequently refers to an area occupied by a nation; a land or country.**—Strong's Concordance

“The above words end and earth are revealing to mankind that great hurricanes will be stirred up by the heating of the oceans and it will cause death and destruction from one coast of a country even to another coast of this country.”

The prophet also shows many of the slain will not receive proper burials nor will they be gathered from the sea. The prophet Yeremyah reveals to a future

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generation devastating hurricanes to be experienced in a future time. Notice this in the following scriptures:

Behold, the whirlwind of Yahweh goes forth with fury, **a continuing whirlwind**: it shall fall with pain upon the head of the wicked. The fierce anger of Yahweh shall not return, until he has done *it*, and until he has performed the intents of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it.

Jeremiah 30:23-24 (KJV)

The word **continuing** written in the above scripture is from the Hebrew word:

גָּרָר **gārar** [<H1641](#)— Genenius’s Hebrew and Chaldea Lexicon to the Old Testament by Wilhelm Genseneius, Samuel Prideaux Tregelles page 181: Used of a whirlwind sweeping away as it were everything.

גָּרָר **gārar** [<H1641](#): The Brown-Driver-Briggs Hebrew and English Lexicon by F. Brown, S. Driver, and C. Briggs page 176: shows this word means: **A sweeping and roaring whirlwind.**

The word Sweeping is found in Webster Dictionary on page 1921 with this meaning: Moving or passing about or over a wide area. Moving, driving or passing steadily and forcibly on.

This is incredible detail concerning the events in our day; the reports showed that Sandy swept across a wide area of space with tropical storm force-winds reaching nearly 950 miles wide, and hurricane force-winds extending 175 miles from the center. Sandy was twice the size of the massive hurricane Katrina which extended 435 miles.

The prophet Yeremyah was inspired to write of these hurricanes which are precursors for massive changes that are prophecy to occur in this generation. The book of Revelation also gives us detail concerning the devastating alteration occurring in the earth. Notice this in the following scriptures

And the third malak sounded, and there fell **a great star from heaven**, burning as it were a lamp, **and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters**; And the **name of the star is called Wormwood**: and the third part of the

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waters became wormwood; **and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter.**

Revelation 8:10-11 (KJV)

The word **fell** written in the above scripture is from the Greek word: **πίπτω**—pipt —4098: probably akin to [<G4072>](#) (petomai) through the idea of *alighting*; to *fall* (literal or figurative):- fall (down), light on. Pipto: The falling down of judgment upon persons, as the sun's heat; to set on fire; to kindle; consume.

The word **alighting** is found in Webster Dictionary page 63 to mean: To settle or stay after descending; to provide with light: light up; to burn; to cause to heat up.

- The word **fell** is describing the effect of a star (the sun's) heat coming down and heating the waters. The word **name** describes the character and reality of what this star produces. The name it is given is wormwood.
- The word **wormwood** is from the Greek word: **ἄψινθος** apsinthos [<G894>](#)—of uncertain derivative; *wormwood* (as a **type of bitterness**, i.e. [figurative] **calamity**) —Strong's Concordance

The word **calamity** is found in the Webster Dictionary page 294: A great misfortune or disaster causing grievous affliction.

Disaster: Webster Dictionary page 561: 1. A calamitous event; especially one occurring suddenly and causing great loss of life, damage, or hardship. 2. A unfavorable aspect of a star or planet. The prefix Dis- is a Latin prefix meaning having a privative, negative or reversing force and the prefix aster (astro) means a star.

The word bitter is from the Greek word: **πικραίνω pikrain [<G4087>](#)—from [<G4089>](#) (pikros); to *embitter* (literal or figurative):- be (make) bitter. Pikraino: means also **to irritate**—Strong's Concordance**

The word **irritate** is from the Webster Dictionary page: 519: to incite ill temper in; **to inflame**; to excite to action.

Inflame: The Webster Dictionary page 499: To excite to violent activity; to arouse the fury of; to heat morbidly.
